How is the PM Report different?

The FastRacks PM Reports contain the same fields as the AM reports, but the information just needs to be interpreted a little differently.

Things to remember:

- Price data is only released **after** it has become effective. Prices on these reports are the prices effective at the time the report is run.
- Most supplier prices are effective at 6pm local time.
 - A few notable exceptions:
 - Exxon updates at 7PM
 - Global updates at both 6PM & 12AM
 - FastRack report delivery time can be adjusted to accommodate the prices that have later effective times.
- During times of heavy demand (such as weather emergencies, etc.), suppliers may change their prices multiple times throughout the day.
- Supplier system or technical difficulties can cause PM prices not to update. These types of delays are infrequent.

How will I know if a PM price is up-to-date?

Check for these 3 indicators:

- Date/Time:** When the Report was generated by DTN
- Confirmed Indicator:** **Y** = confirmed, **N** = unconfirmed (unconfirmed prices are not included in averages/highs/lows). This equals Y for an updated price.
- Move Date:** Date of most recent price move of the first product listed in each line. This is not the same as the effective date.

A price is updated when the confirmation is **Y** and the **move date** matches the **Date/Time**. For example, Item 4 is up-to-date, whereas Item 5 is not.
